Have you ever been betrayed by a friend, co-worker, or spouse? People who experience betrayal often experience deep feelings of anger and resentment towards their betrayers resulting in extended periods of deep anxiety and conflict. Could a different attitude lead to different results? In our Mass today we will hear two stories of betrayal, the first is the betrayal of Joseph by his own brothers as they sell him into slavery, and second is the betrayal of God by Israel's rejection of God's law and the prophets. Joseph and Jesus could have taken their rejections personally, but they trusted in God. For those of you who are familiar with Joseph's story, he ultimately is saved from death and ends up saving the Egyptians as well as the very people who sold him into slavery. Jesus didn't just end up saving a country or a family, he saved humanity. Both Jesus and Joseph teach us that hope filled people trust that God can make good out of a terrible situation. What difficult challenges are you facing now? Can you trust God to make your situation good? As we pray this morning, let us pray for an increase in hope and trust in God.

Heavenly Father, you gave your only Son so that we might be saved and have a more abundant life. Help your Assumption family to gaze upon the wonders of your work, so that we might be reminded to trust that you can make all things good. We make this prayer through Christ our Lord. Amen.
