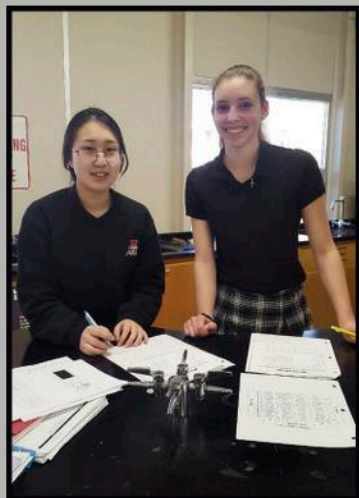
Social Studies Department



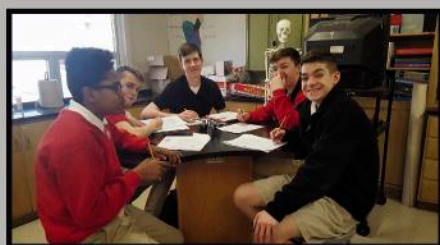

Mr. Simpson teaches US History, AP US History, Psychology, and Gaming Design. Mr. Timm teaches American Government, AP American Government, Current Issues, and Sociology. Ms. Bush teaches College Introduction to Sociology.

Science



The Assumption High School Science Department believes students learn best when dedicated, enthusiastic teachers present them with real-world questions, interesting subject matter, and challenging, hands-on coursework. As a team, science teachers at Assumption develop organized, streamlined, and highly relevant curriculum designed to encourage students to think critically, solve problems, develop inquiry-based lab techniques, and apply evidence and scientific principles to provide explanations and make real-world connections.

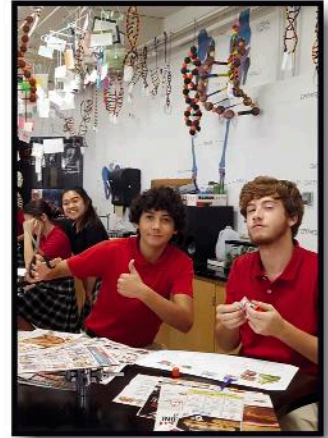


All of the core science classes- Biology, Chemistry, and Physics- begin with the same basic foundation: scientific inquiry, scientific methods, and data analysis. Teachers and students then build together from there, with each grade level taking the core concepts.



Wellness

Wellness is a comprehensive class designed to cover the following topics: mental and emotional health, nutrition, exercise, substance abuse, diseases, environmental health, and community health.

This is an introductory class emphasizing nutritional choices, food safety, kitchen management, meal planning, and the ministry of hospitality.

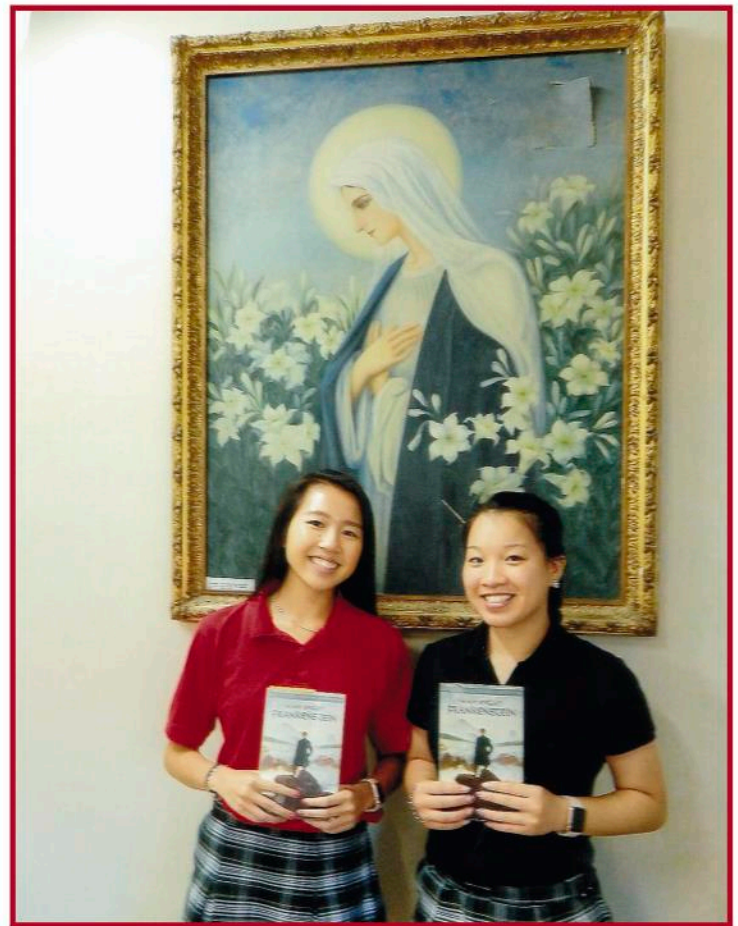


Foods 2

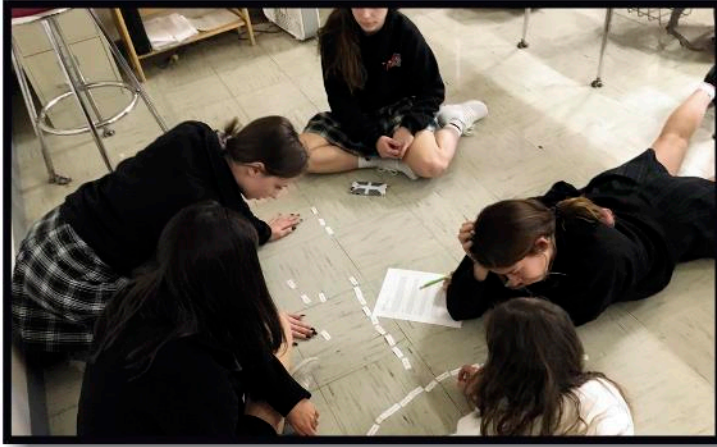

Math

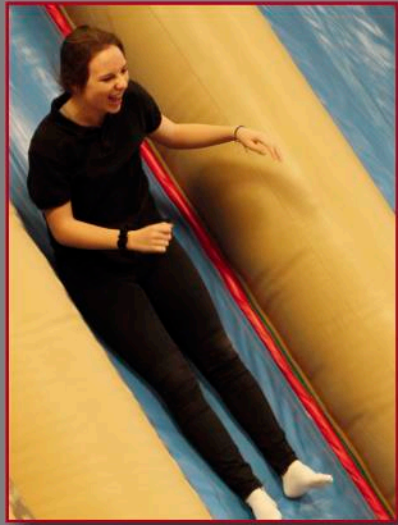

Academic Decathlon is the premier scholastic competition for high-school students (it's one part paper-and-pencil testing, one part speech-giving, and one-part Quiz Bowl). This club presents students with a unique, interdisciplinary approach to developing their academic and interpersonal skills by bringing together academics, communication, and teambuilding in a competitive framework that reinvigorates learning. Because each Decathlete participates in all ten Decathlon events, students participating in the program enjoy a well-rounded scholastic experience that enables them to develop their strengths and overcome their weaknesses. Decathlon events include subject tests in seven academic categories (Art, Music, Economics, Literature, Science, Math, and Social Studies); students also participate in three subjective events (Essay, Interview, and Speech).

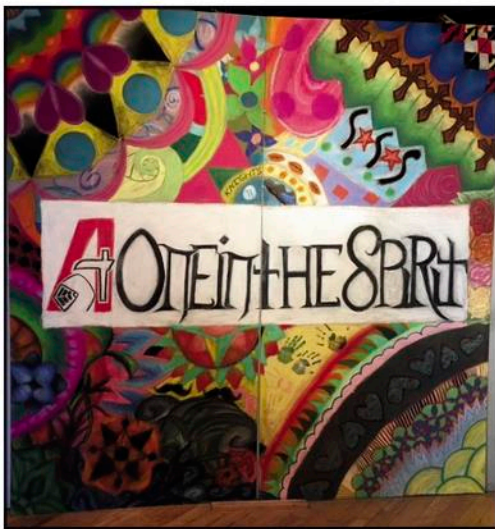
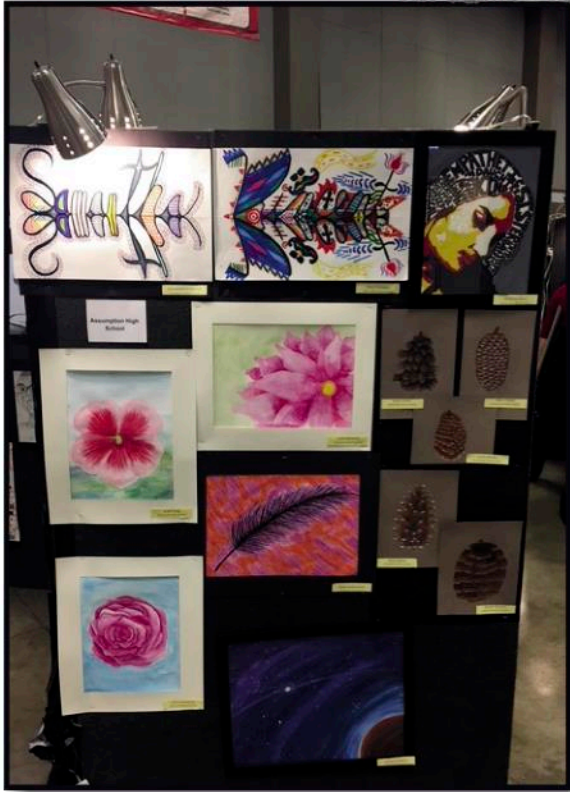
Requirements: Participating in Academic Decathlon requires studying on one's own, preparing a speech, preparing a study guide based on one of the seven academic categories (of your choice), once-a-week attendance at our 10-minute meetings, and intention to compete at the January regional competition. The club meets Friday mornings from 7:30 to 7:40. Meetings begin the first Friday in October.

Competitions: There are two competition weekends: regionals are held January 27th, and state is in March. If we should make it to the national competition, it is held in April.

Art with a Purpose

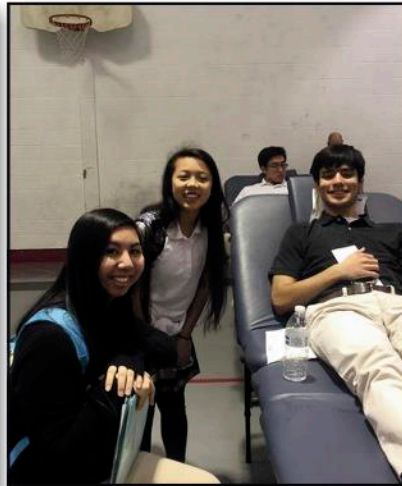
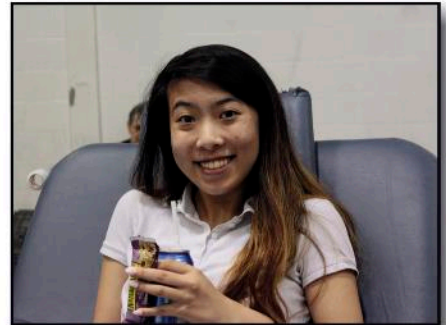

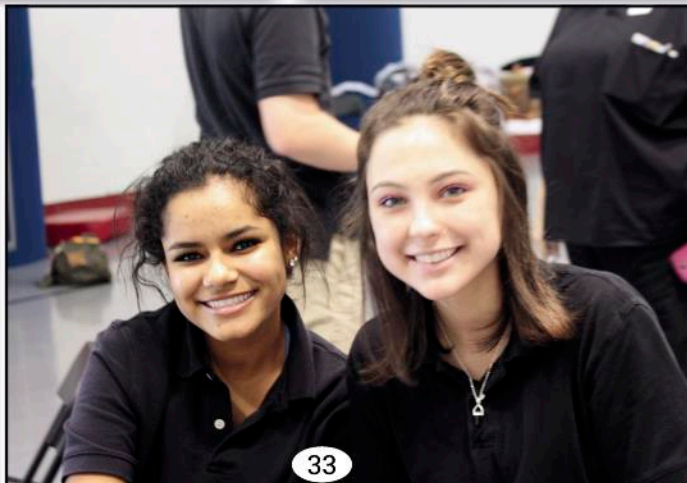
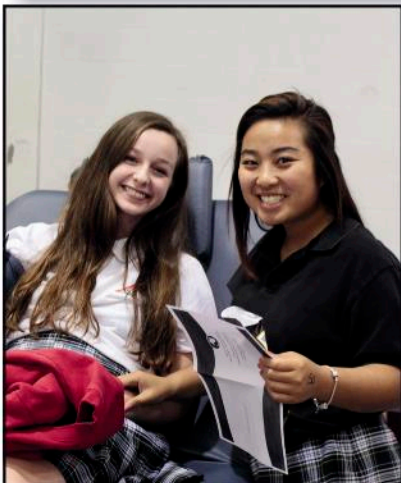
BLOOD DRIVE

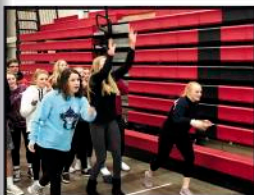

CHOIR



Choir students learn about musicianship by studying quality choral literature of various musical styles and time periods. Every student learns to read music and understand musical concepts. Each choir student is required to attend private and group lessons to develop his or her individual vocal skills and music literacy. The choir presents 4 curricular concerts throughout the year, sings for 4 weekend Masses at area parishes, and participates in the IHSMA Large Group Festival. Select students also prepare to audition for the All-State Chorus and the IHSMA Solo/Ensemble Festival.

2017 Boys Soccer State Runner-Up



The Assumption Boys' Soccer Team earned its first trip to the Iowa Class 1A State Tournament in 14 years, making it all the way to the State Championship game on June 3 at the James W. Cownie Soccer Complex in Des Moines before falling to Iowa City Regina by the score of 1-0. Under longtime head coach Greg Zeller, the Knights defeated Gilbert 2-1 in the semifinals, after dispatching of Garner-Hayfield-Ventura 6-0 in the quarterfinal round. A 7-1 district final win over Clinton Prince of Peace, along with a 4-0 substate victory over Danville, propelled Assumption back to state for the first time since 2003. Following the season, junior Sam Moore, who set a single-season school record with 21 goals, was named First Team All-State by the Iowa High School Soccer Coaches Association. Moore, along with fellow junior Trent Fitzpatrick, were both First Team All-Conference selections, while seniors Ben Beutel and Alex Terrell were Second Team honorees. The Knights finished the year 16-7 overall and return a strong core next year.

2017 Girls Soccer State Champions



The Assumption Girls' Soccer Team won its second consecutive Iowa Class 1A State Tournament title, marking the program's sixth state title in the last seven years. A convincing 3-0 championship game win over Center Point-Urbana on June 10 at the James W. Cownie Soccer Complex in Des Moines, marked the eighth time the Lady Knights have claimed the Iowa Class 1A state trophy.

Making their 11th straight appearance at the State Tournament, the Knights downed Nevada 2-0 in the semifinals, after setting a new state tournament record with 9 goals in their 9-0 win over Iowa City Regina in the quarterfinals. Assumption set a new all-class goal total record with 14 scores in the tournament's three games.

Sophomores Carly King and Anna Vonderhaar, were named to the Class 1A All-Tournament Team, as were juniors Bridget Poster and Molly Gervase (captain). Following the tournament, Gervase and junior Annie Argo were voted 2017 Iowa Class 1A First Team All-State by the Iowa Girls Coaches Association. The Lady Knights finished the year 19-2 (7-2 MAC) overall under second-year head coach Elizabeth Maus '03.



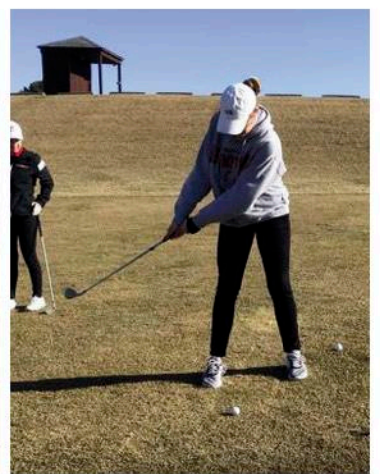
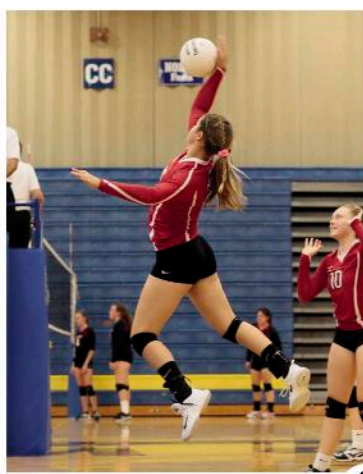
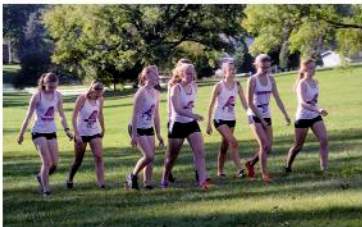
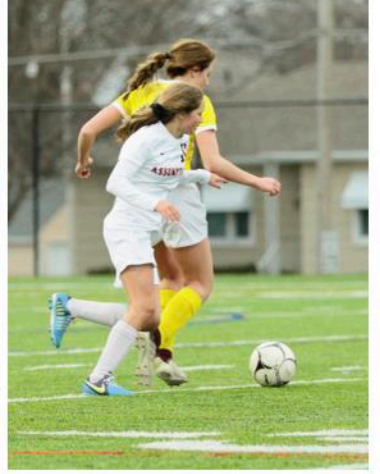

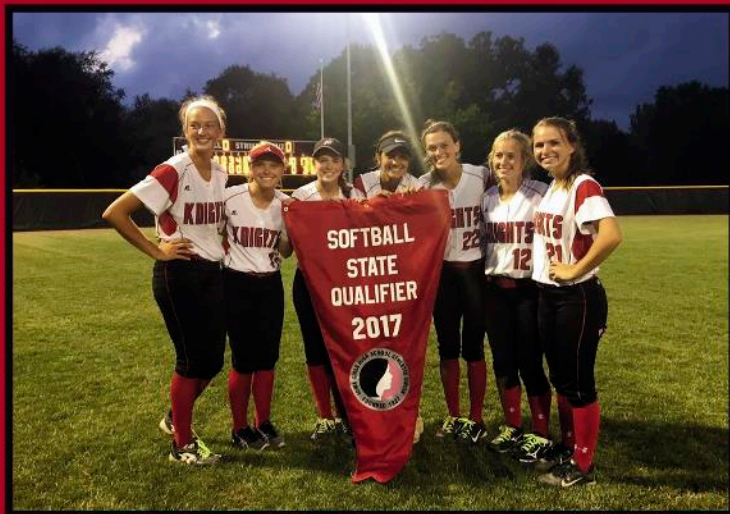
The Assumption Girls Track & Field program made state history with its fifth consecutive Iowa Class 3A State Girls Track & Field Championship, becoming the first program in the 56-year history of the state meet to claim five straight championships. Powered by senior Joy Ripslinger's four individual titles and two runner-up finishes by sophomore Carly King, Assumption topped second place Pella 93-77 in overall points.

At the 2017 Drake Relays, the Lady Knights claimed three more coveted white flags for the trophy case, as Ripslinger won both the 800 and 1500 M races, and AHS topped the field in the 4 x 100 M Relay behind the efforts of Jasmine Harris, Carly King, Lea Nelson and Mary Grace Carroll. For the second straight year, Assumption was named the Drake Relays Hy-Vee Cup Champions, earning the distinction of the top high school girls track program in Iowa.

At the 2017 New Balance Outdoor National Championships in Greensboro, NC, Harris, Nelson, King and Ripslinger clocked a time of 3 minutes, 55.74 seconds in the 1600-meter medley, setting a new all-time Iowa best. Assumption's time was the fourth fastest time in the country this season, earning the quartet All-American honors.



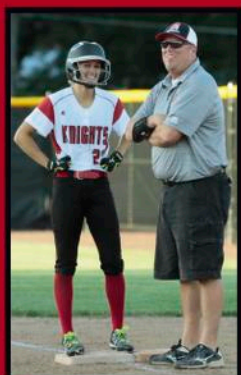
Softball Summer 2017

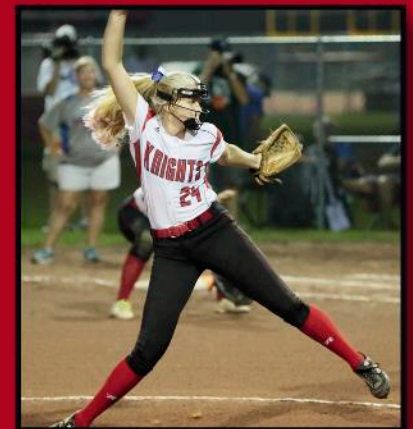

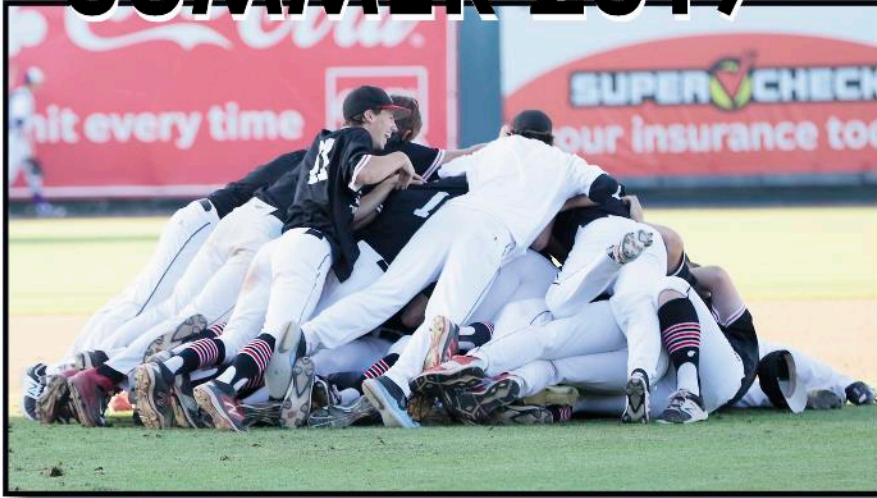

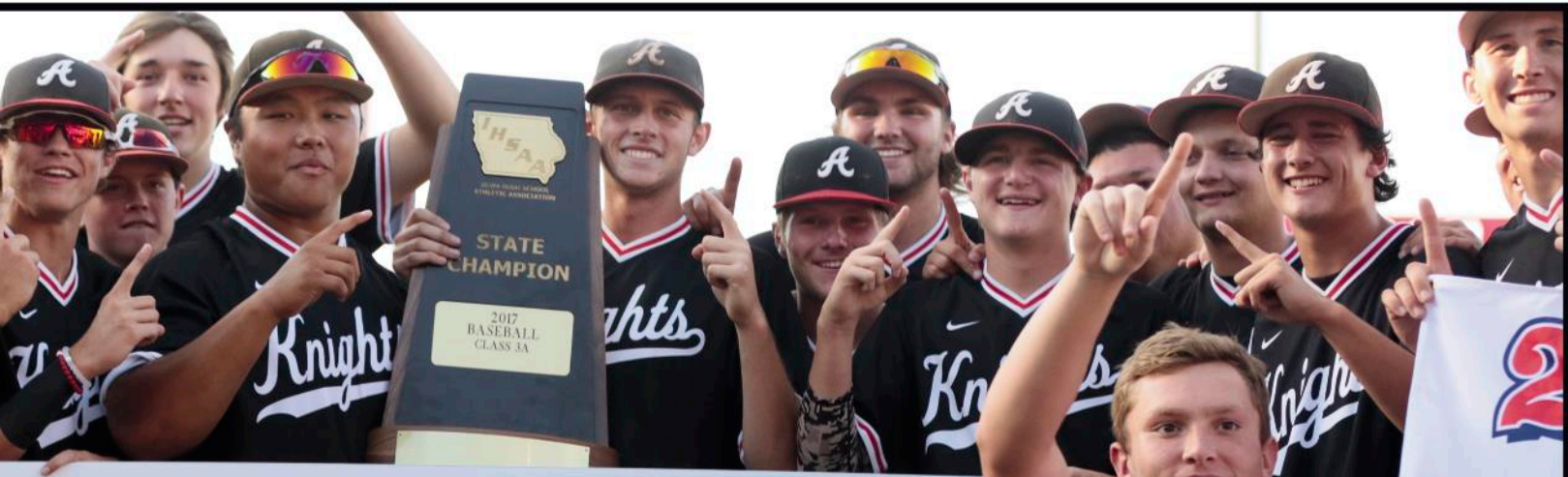


The 2017 Assumption Baseball season was also one for the record books, with the Knights breaking through for a state record-setting 10th state title. Behind aces Trenton Wallace, Ben Beutel, and Daniel Powers, the Knights dominated their competition from start to finish, capping the season with a 10-1 win over Harlan in the Iowa Class 3A State Tournament Championship on August 29 at Principal Park in Des Moines. The Knights gave Head Coach Billy Argo his 500th career coaching victory on July 11, while also enjoying winning streaks of five, nine, 10, and 16 games, en route to an overall record of 41-5. In conference play, the Knights went 16-2 on the way to their second straight MAC title, and 16th league banner all-time. For the second straight season, Wallace, now pitching for the University of Iowa, was named to the IHSBCA Super Team, and was also voted First Team All-State by the Iowa Newspaper Association (INA) and the Des Moines Register.
