

With their resilient performance, Katie Engel and Ansan Nguyen won the competition and blew the audience away.











































Religion ±




One of the best parts of Unplugged is therapy dogs. These dogs allow students to destress.




Regionals







Making their 13th straight appearance at the State Tournament, the Knights toppled St. Albert 10-0 in the quarterfinals, and followed up with a 2-0 victory over Gilbert.

Seniors Livy Lansing and Anna Vonderhaar, and freshman Jade Jackson were named to the Class 1A All-Tournament Team, while senior forward Carly King was named All-Tournament Captain.

Following the tournament, King, Lansing, and junior defender Abbey Klostermann were voted 2018 Iowa Class 1A First Team All-State by the Iowa Girls Coaches Association (IGCA), while Vonderhaar, Lauren Herrig, Sully Kelly, and Jade Jackson were all named Second Team All-State by the IGCA.

King, who finished her career with 101 goals, was tabbed Elite All-lowa and First Team Class 1A by the Des Moines Register, while Herrig was also a First Team pick by the Register.
