Event Policies:

Students are expected to be on time for the event. (Photos can be taken outdoors between 7:00 and 7:30, but all students must be in their first activity for a prompt 7:30 start.

Students are to be in attendance until the end of the event at 11pm unless parent notification is made to school officials.

When a student leaves the event, he/she must leave the school and cannot return.

This is a dress-up event. Attire can range from Sunday best to last year’s Prom dresses that were not able to be worn. All dress must be modest, appropriate, and respectful.

Students will be able to pre-schedule time blocks (via Sign-up Genius) for socially-distant activities that will be held on the AHS campus throughout the evening. Snacks, desserts, and drinks will be included in the ticket price. The evening will include a great mix of entertainment, fellowship, and fun, and many memories are sure to be made for AHS students in grades 10-12. (Students wishing to invite a guest from another school should stop in the front office to pick up a permission form.)

Much like we have been able to successfully operate our school day, students will be able to spend time together at a safe social distance throughout the evening activities. Careful planning will be necessary to ensure location capacities are compatible with spacing requirements. **Out of Uniform Note:** Students will pay for out of uniform during lunch periods and be checked in their 6th hour class. Students who do not have proper out of uniform verification will be issued Dress Code violations. Day-specific hand stamps will be used to serve as a pass.
