
solve when planning all of these events. We grew as individuals and as a whole, and we remained "one in the spirit" through it all.










Homecoming Dance "Socially Distant Social"

In Anatomy, students learn about our bodies' anatomy and physiology. They do labs, perform dissections, interact with Stan the Skeleton, and do case studies about diseases.







After just missing out on a fifth straight appearance in the state championship game, the Knights took a 2-0 lead in the top of the first inning and didn't look back, riding the arm of junior Libby Madden to a 4-1 win over the Mustangs.

In the quarterfinal round, the second-seeded Knights scored 15 runs on 10 hits en route to a 15-0 three-inning victory over seventh-seeded Boyden-Hull/Rock Valley.

Following the tournament, catcher Anna Wohlers and shortstop Maddie Loken were named to the Class 3A All-Tournament Team.

During the regular season, the Knights finished second in the Mississippi Athletic Conference standings (13-3 MAC) and compiled a 21-6 overall record.

Following the season, Wohlers was named 2020 First Team All-State Class 3A by the Iowa Girls Coaches Association (IGCA), marking the third year in a row she has earned first team honors, as well as Class 3A All-Iowa by the Des Moines Register (2nd time). Both Lauren Loken and Olivia Wardlow were Second Team All-State selections by the IGCA.

Senior third baseman Carlie Sammon '20 will continue her softball career at the Minnesota State - Mankato, while fellow grad Gracie Jevyak '20 will join the softball program at Indian Hills.


