- Dodgeball: 9:05-10:25 Large Gym (Grades 11/12), Small Gym (9/10)-compete with 3<sup>rd</sup> period classes
- All students and staff should report to the appropriate gym (designated by 3<sup>rd</sup> period teacher) and gather with your 3<sup>rd</sup> period teams. Each 3<sup>rd</sup> period teacher should be sure that the 10 dodgeball players representing his or her class are ready to go when called. Games will be played on a time-limit, and in each game, the team with the most players standing at the buzzer will advance to the next round. Play will be single-elimination. All members of the winning 3<sup>rd</sup> period class will be allowed to go first in the lunch line on Friday, February 11<sup>th</sup>.
- This event will also be used to promote the school-wide collection of diapers for the Scott County Catholic Schools K-12 diaper drive. Throughout the week, members of Student Council will collect diaper donations from classrooms.
